

All students are expected to choose a minimum of one grade level book from the summer reading list.


Grade 6 - Unit 1 "Understanding"




Grade 7: Unit 1 "Overcoming Struggle"




Grade 8: Unit 1 "Narrative Writing/Mentor Texts"


