### Shore Resort Areas Expect Christmas Rush

TRENTON—Sightseeing will be one of the principal activities for visitors to New Jersey during the Christmas holidays, report officials of the New Jersey Department of Conservation and

Economic Development. A flood of early hotel reservations at leading shore resorts and inland winter resorts has led some resort officials to predict that this will be one of the State's best winter seasons.

Atlantic City has produced a unique boardwalk lighting display, which will afford skating pleasure regardless of the temperature. Sponsored by the Lakewood Recreation Company, the artificial rink will feature a professional skating instructor and ice carnivals.

A Christmas lighting contest will spark attractions for vacationers at Long Branch. This resort is presently preparing for a variety of interesting shows and events, which will augment this center's Centennial Celebration and the Diamond Jubilee of the Electric Light.

Starting December 21 Christmas carols will be broadcast to the public from City Hall, at Ocean City, and eighteenth will be viewing the Christmas lighting display and decorated show windows. Later in December attractions at this community will herald the City's Diamond Jubilee Celebration of 75 years of progress as "America's Greatest Family Recreation Center."

Asbury Park officials report that hotels are planning special attractions for "Christmas Week" visitors, and restaurants will feature varied cuisine for hungry boardwalk and city strollers. Plans are already under way to

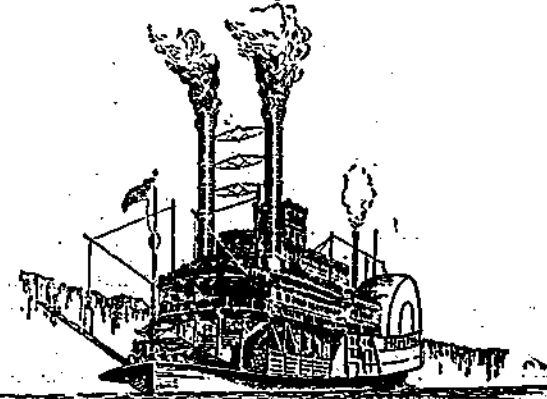

# WASHINGTON NEWS

ON BARREN GROUND  
After months of deliberation and suspense, President Eisenhower delivered his "Operation Cauder" address with suddenness and dramatic effect before the General Assembly of the United Nations—flying directly to New York from the Big Three confer-

ence in Bermuda for the occasion. While the President's speech contained a terse reference to the mounting horror of atomic weapons, in which he intimated we still hold the quantitative lead, it was essentially another fervent plea to the nations of the world to put into operation, while there

is yet time, a working plan "to strip its military casing" from this boundless atomic force "and adapt it to the arts of peace." In spite of the tremendous applause that followed the President's address, the Moscow radio required only 24 hours to organize its scolding commentary on the speech, even going so far as to declare that President Eisenhower "had threatened atomic war."

At the White House, Press Secretary James C. Hagerty read a statement to the effect that "immediate reactions" do not "necessarily represent the considered decision of the Soviet government." Immediately before adjournment of the General Assembly, however, Mr. Vishinsky strongly implied Russian rejection of the Eisenhower plan for stockpiling fissionable material for peaceful use. Without "unconditional prohibition of atomic weapons," there could be no "strengthening of peace and international cooperation," he declared. Next day, the 70th birthday, the Kremlin awarded him the "Order of Lenin" for "outstanding service to the Soviet state." Thus, despite White House spokesmen, we do not think Mr. Malenkov's boy was talking through his hat.

It should be remembered that the Russian plan, approved by a majority of the U.N., contained strong controls over atomic weapons, which Mr. Vishinsky now says are essential. But it also contained equally strong provision for inspection and punishment of violators—which Russia did not want, and hence killed the plan. . . . In 1946, Plainly Russia has no desire to end the cold war. It has been too successful. And Russia knows that the Western Powers will need to be the one to heat it up. The President has made a noble and sincere effort however, and one that should bring the allies closer together—it only in frustra-

A heart that has repaired itself in this manner is a damaged heart, but a serviceable one. Medical research, much of it paid for by contributions to the annual Heart Fund appeal, has provided doctors with the information they need in order to tell you how to live with a damaged heart. And in most cases, persons who have suffered heart attacks find they can continue to do most of the things they have always done—in moderation.

Fear of heart disease has created the mistaken impression that most heart attacks are fatal. Nothing could be further from the truth. Actually, 85 per cent of all persons who suffer heart attacks recover, and only a small portion of these are disabled. Most of them are able to continue with their regular business and social activities.

The usual "heart attack," in medical terminology, is a coronary thrombosis. This means that a clot, or thrombus, forms inside a tenth of its capacity. The other nine-tenths of its energy can be devoted to building up the new circulation system.

A heart that has repaired itself in this manner is a damaged heart, but a serviceable one. Medical research, much of it paid for by contributions to the annual Heart Fund appeal, has provided doctors with the information they need in order to tell you how to live with a damaged heart. And in most cases, persons who have suffered heart attacks find they can continue to do most of the things they have always done—in moderation.
