

After a 19-month series of clinical tests, four New England doctors reported in a recent issue of the American Journal of Proctology that the purer the alcohol you consume, the lest chance of hangover. Also, they say, the purer the alcohol, the slower it intoxicates.

What causes distress of hangover are the congeners are impurities found in distilled spirits such as acids, esters, aldehydes, furfural, fusel oil and tannins.

According to the researchers,—"Based on the toxicity of the congeners in distilled spirits, results indicate that these substances play a role in both the immediate and alter-effects experienced by drinkers."

It can be deducted from this study that blended whiskey, which contains less toxic impurities than straight whisky, is less likely to fause uncomfortable after-effects.

The four scientists who participated in the New England tests are Dr. Charles A. Brusch of Harvard Medical School; Dr. Prodromos N. Papas and Dr. Frank A. Straccia, both of Tufts College School of Medicine. Medford, Mass.
