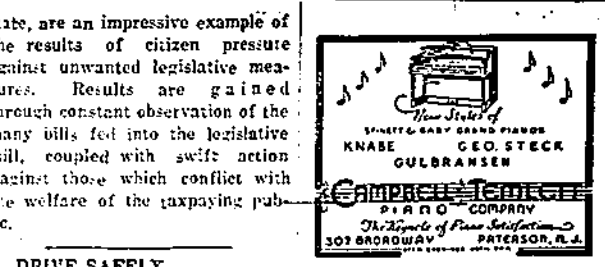
Achievements of the New Jersey  
Taxpayers' Association, work-  
ing in concert with local units  
in communities throughout the  
state, are an impressive example of  
the results of citizen pressure  
against unwanted legislative mea-  
sures.

Generally these bills provide that  
those who have held office for a  
period of, say, five years, automati-  
cally gain tenure of office and  
cannot be removed except "for  
just cause."

An example of this type of leg-  
islation is Senate Bill 103, which  
would grant tenure after five  
years' service to municipal com-  
ptrollers, treasurers and tax collec-  
tors, and which in time would make  
all these positions appointive. Thus  
citizens of communities now en-  
joying the privilege of electing these  
officers would lose this privi-  
lege.

Tenure bills are introduced into  
the legislature despite the fact that  
the public seldom favors them, and  
despite the fact that they are for  
the benefit of special individuals  
who wish to keep their positions  
without the formality of seeking  
re-election or re-appointment.  
Many of these public officers are  
banded together into state-wide  
associations and are therefore in a  
position to apply organized pres-  
sure upon the legislature.

Organized effort by taxpayers  
associations and other citizen  
groups is the most effective means  
of combating this organized effort  
by "pressure" groups of public  
officers. No matter how  
strongly the legislature are urged  
to pass special legislation they can-  
not ignore public sentiment if it is  
organized and articulate. If the

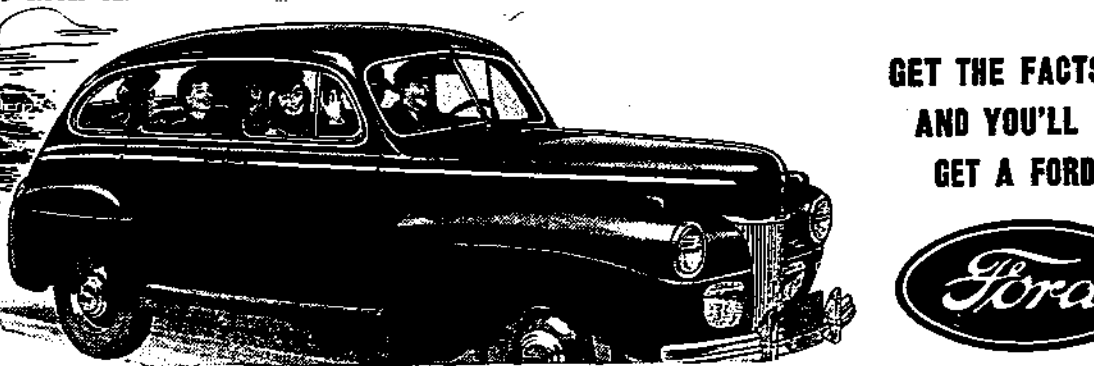
