During the month of April, the Hawthorne County Tuberculosis Association, in cooperation with the National Tuberculosis Association, sponsors an extensive health education program, known as "The Early Diagnosis Campaign," the object of this year being, "Fight Tuberculosis with Modern Weapons."

This campaign will be nationwide. Popular education is to be the method and thought will be the motto. The County Association will have available during next month speakers and moving pictures which will be on call ready to visit any organized group throughout the county desiring to learn something about this disease. All that is necessary to have this service is a telephone call or letter to the office in Paterson and such a program will be gladly arranged for any organization.

What are the modern weapons in this war on tuberculosis? One of the newer methods, and the one which needs to be better understood by the public, is splinting the lung, known to physicians as collapse treatment. It is a surgery. Not cutting off of diseased tissue used in breaking, but a method of putting the diseased lung at rest, as one would splint a broken bone, thus enabling it to heal.

The splinting of the lung cavity, doing this is called pneumothorax. Air is injected between the lung and the chest wall, under slight pressure, great enough to collapse it. Collapse of the lung cavity improves the germ-killing by the coughed up and cannot infect others.
