50,000 FEDERAL EMPLOYEES WORKING IN NEW JERSEY Gordon Canfield There were 50,356 Federal Government employees located in New Jersey at the close of the fiscal year last June 30. This rep-

New Jersey at the close of the fiscal year last June 30. This represented a decline of more than 5,000 in the Federal working force in this State since 1952.

The figures, just released by the U. S. Civil Service Commission, also show that Federal employment in New Jersey during the one-year period since June 30. 1955 declined one per cent. Largest force of Federal workers in New Jersey was under the Defined Department which listed 28, 265 employees on June 30 last, as compared with 29,056 a year earlier. Post Office Department employment during the one-year period in New Jersey dropped from 13,056 to 12,975. The Veterans Administration payroll in the State also declined slightly from 3,760 in 1955 to 3,689 last June. Other departments and agencies reported an aggregate increase in employment over the one-year period from 4,358 to 4,824.
