tional defense training, the conference this year, usually sponsored by the University Extension Division and the College of Engineering, will be under the auspices of the University's Engineering Defense Training Unit. This newly-created unit, consisting of the faculties of the two divisions, is operating under the United States Office of Education, large defense training projects for industry in all sections of the State, offering technical training in engineering and management to all types of defense workers.

The leading speaker on the day program will be Lieut. Col. Frank J. McCarthy, chief of the defense training branch, Labor Division,

Office of Production Management, Washington, who will describe the coordination of the training programs of such Federal agencies as the Engineering, Science and Management Defense Training, the Vocational Division of the United States Department of Education, the NYA, the CCC and the WPA.
